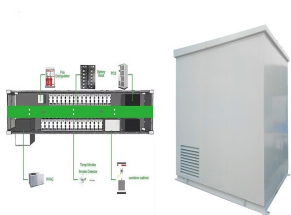


# COMOROS BANK ENERGY STORAGE PLANT

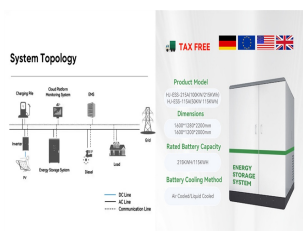
