Could nuclear power be a solution to Iraq's energy crisis? Part of Iraq's nation-building strategy is ensuring greater access to electricity, and Baghdad sees nuclear power as an attractive way to address this challenge. The proposed eight-reactor plan would provide the country with a steady 11 gigawatts of power, bridging the gap between supply and demand even during the hottest part of the year.



Will Iraq build 8 nuclear reactors? In June, Kamal Hussein Latif, chairman of the Iraqi Radioactive Sources Regulatory Authority, said the Iraqi government is currently in talks with Russia's Rosatom about a \$40 billion plan to build eight nuclear reactors. Latif also said Iraq discussed the plan with French, American and South Korean officials.



Where were the nuclear facilities located in Baghdad? All of these facilities were located at the Tuwaitha Nuclear Research Center near Baghdad, and with the exception of the Italian-supplied hot cell plutonium handling facility, were placed under IAEA safeguards.



Should Iraq introduce nuclear technology? Proliferation is another major concern. The Iraqi power grid has weathered 35 terror attacks so far this year. Introducing nuclear technology would increase the risk of nuclear material falling into terrorist hands, either through a direct attack on a nuclear facility or via a corrupt government official.



What is Iraq's nuclear legacy? Iraq's nuclear legacy. Iraq received its first research reactor from the Soviet Union in 1962, and acquired several more over the next two decades.

Was Iraq hiding a nuclear weapons program? Iraq was reluctant to cooperate with international inspectors, however, which, coupled with then-President Saddam Hussein's tendency to exaggerate his country's weapons-of-mass-destruction capabilities, led US intelligence agencies to incorrectly assess that Iraq was hiding a nuclear weapons program.
