The capital city of Sao Tome and Principe is home to about 60,000 of the country's inhabitants. A highlight is the Sao Sebastiao Museum, which incorporates the first fort to be built on Sao Tome.







The project in S?o Tom? and Pr?ncipe is a public-private partnership between Global OTEC and SIDS DOCK, the Small Island Developing States (SIDS) Sustainable Energy and Climate Resilient Organization and is seen as a key way for the region to reduce the dependence on costly fossil fuels and drive the energy transition.



However, the nation's abundant renewable energy resources, such as solar, wind, and hydropower, present a unique opportunity to transform its energy market and pave the way for sustainable development. One of the primary reasons for S?o Tom? and Pr?ncipe's reliance on fossil fuels is the lack of a robust energy infrastructure.



Cocoa is currently the islands's top cash crop, as cocoa makes up 70-80% of the country's exports by value. "In 2021, S?o Tom? and Pr?ncipe exported USD17 million in Cocoa Beans, making it the 28th largest exporter of cocoa beans in the world," according to Observatory of Economic Complexity (OEC) .

In 2022, S?o Tom? & Pr?ncipe's electricity consumption was overwhelmingly dependent on fossil fuels, with almost 93% of the electricity generated coming from these sources.
