REUTERS/Yara Nardi/File Photo Purchase Licensing Rights VATICAN CITY, June 26 (Reuters) - Pope Francis, a vocal campaigner for action against climate change and on environmental protection, on Wednesday ordered the construction of a solar farmto cover the energy needs of the Vatican City State.



Could a solar farm be bigger than the Vatican City? Plans for a massive solar farm in Mid Devon that would be bigger than the Vatican City have been lodged. The Langford Solar Farm Application Site would occupy approximately 61 hectares of agricultural land to the east and north-east of the village of Langford.



Where should a solar farm be built? Expressing his wishes in a Motu Proprio,a personal papal edict,the 87-year-old pontiff said the solar farm should be built outside Vatican walls,in Santa Maria Galeria in the northwestern outskirts of Rome. The area belongs to the Vatican and already hosts a broadcasting centre for Vatican Radio,which will also be powered by the new solar farm.



Where is the agrivoltaic plant located? The agrivoltaic plant will make use of the Holy See???s property at Santa Maria di Galeria. Located on the edge of Rome, the 424-hectare site houses the transmission facilities for Vatican Radio, thanks to a 1951 agreement between the Holy See and the Italian State.



Galeria, located outside of Rome and an extra-territory of Vatican City.






Citing the Vatican's pledge in U.N. climate treaties to curb carbon emissions, Francis tasked a commission of Vatican officials with developing the solar farm at Santa Maria di Galeria. In a decree, he said the solar energy generated would be sufficient to fuel not only the radio operations there but the Vatican City State itself.
