

SOLAR POWER PLANT IN IRAQ



Does Iraq have a solar power plant? The contracts also cover a water intake project for injection into oil reservoirs. The solar power plant will be Iraq's first utility-scale solar power project. While the country has several other solar plans in the pipeline, the TotalEnergies project is the first to proceed to the implementation phase.



Will TotalEnergies build a solar power plant in Iraq? French energy major TotalEnergies will build a 1-gigawatt solar power plant in Iraq as part of a cluster of contracts it was awarded in 2021 for an integrated project that entails a total investment of \$27 billion over 30 years.



What is Iraq's solar project? The project aims to improve Iraq's electricity supply and increase regional oil production while also recovering flared gas and building a seawater treatment plant. The Saudi company ACWA Power has been invited to join the solar project.

The two companies will share ownership of the project, pending regulatory approvals.



Will ACWA Power join a solar project in Iraq? TotalEnergies will invite ACWA Power, a Saudi company, to join the solar project in agreement with Iraqi authorities. The project is expected to attract foreign investment and support the country's transition to renewable energy.



How much solar capacity will Iraq have by 2030? Iraq's solar plans announced in November 2021 call for the addition of 12 gigawatts of solar capacity by 2030. Some 7.5 gigawatts of the planned solar capacity are to come from utility-scale solar plants, and Iraq has reached agreements with

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developers ??? at varying stages ??? for projects that will add 4.5 gigawatts of the total.

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Masdar, the Abu Dhabi Future Energy Company, is in talks to develop a 1,000 MW solar power plant in Iraq. Discussions were held with Iraqi Electricity Minister Ali Fadil in Baghdad, and the project is expected to undergo cabinet approval, including considerations for tax exemptions, according to the Iraqi News Agency.



CAIRO, Aug 25 (Reuters) - Iraq has signed an initial agreement with POWERCHINA to build solar power plants with a capacity of 2,000 megawatts, the government said on Wednesday.

Among the agreed large-scale solar schemes are three projects totalling 2.75 GW that are expected to be connected to the grid in 2025. These include a 1-GW contract with UAE's renewable energy company Masdar, a pact with TotalEnergies SE (EPA:TTE) for a 1-GWp solar complex and 750 MW of solar capacity to be deployed by Chinese state-owned ???

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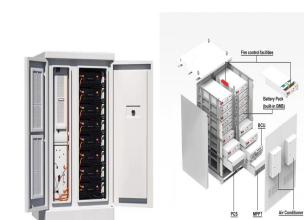
The power plant is an off-grid 2.5 MW PV solar power plant with 2.5 MWh battery energy storage system. After we put this plant into operation, it has already saved us 1,732 liters diesel per day. Additionally, solar energy is a zero emission energy, so it also help to reduce the emission of greenhouse gases.



Chinese state-owned Power Construction Corporation of China (PowerChina) has signed an agreement with Iraq's Ministry of Electricity to develop its first solar power plant in the country, media reports said. The solar power plant will have a capacity of 2000 MW.

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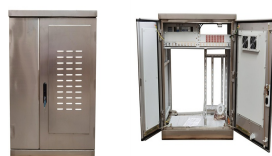
