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The RBF approach for energy access fit the challenge of electrifying Solomon Islands for several reasons. Initial high upfront costs created significant affordability challenges for people in Solomon Islands. Based on an initial World Bank assessment, the willingness to pay for electricity was quite evident.





Solar PV is used widely in the Pacific and there is capacity to handle design, installation, repairs and maintenance work in the Solomon Islands. Solomon Islands has great hydro-power potential resource (roughly 200-300MW in total) and needs careful planning to harness this source of energy to ensure its sustainability as a renewable energy
