



Is South Georgia a small island? It is a remote and inhospitable collection of islands, consisting of South Georgia and a chain of smaller islands known as the South Sandwich Islands. South Georgia is 165 kilometres (103 mi) long and 35 kilometres (22 mi) wide and is by far the largest island in the territory.

Most of the islands, rising steeply from the sea, are rugged and mountainous. At higher elevations, the islands are permanently covered with ice and snow.





What happened to South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands? In 1985, South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands ceased to be administered as a Falkland Islands Dependency and became a separate territory. The King Edward Point base, which had become a small military garrison after the Falklands War, returned to civilian use in 2001 and is now operated by the British Antarctic Survey.

In January 1775 Captain James Cook, in the ship Resolution discovered the Isle of Georgia, which he had named in honour of King George III. It soon became known as South Georgia. Likewise, the neighbouring Sandwich Lands, which he named in honour of the Earl of Sandwich, First Lord of the Admiralty, became known as the South Sandwich Islands.

The territory of South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands was formed in 1985. Argentina raised a territorial claim for South Georgia in 1927 and for the South Sandwich Islands in 1938. Argentina maintained a naval station, Corbeta Uruguay on Thule Island in the South Sandwich Islands from 1976 until 1982 when it was closed by the Royal Navy



Together, South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands form part of the Scotia Arc, which extends from the tip of South America to Antarctica (and also includes the South Shetland and South Orkney Islands, though these are not part of the British dependency). The island of South Georgia is 105 mi (170 km) long, and about 25 mi (40 km) wide.
