This approach is also a creative way to support peacebuilding. Since 2005, the UN has had a peacekeeping mission in what is now South Sudan, with the current iteration, the UN Mission in South Sudan (UNMISS), deployed since independence in 2011. The mission is one of the largest in the world, with an annual budget of \$1.12 billion as of July 2022.



Since independence, South Sudan has faced several severe episodes of fuel shortages, initially because of closure of borders with the Sudan, and more recently due to lack of local depots and refineries. First, one of the major challenges in the downstream sector in South Sudan is lack of adequate depot infrastructure. South Sudan's demands

South Sudan's energy sector is critical to its economy, as oil exports account for a significant chunk of its revenue. The country's oil deposits, which are predominantly concentrated in the oil-rich regions of Unity, The country's building of pipelines, refineries, and storage facilities intends to increase the transportation and storage



The Juba Solar Power Station is a proposed 20 MW (27,000 hp) solar power plant in South Sudan. The solar farm is under development by a consortium comprising Elsewedy Electric Company of Egypt, Asunim Solar from the United Arab Emirates (UAE) and I-kWh Company, an energy consultancy firm also based in the UAE. The solar farm will have an attached battery energy storage system rated at 35MWh. The off-taker is the South Sudanese Ministry of Electricity, Da???



The discovery of oil, mainly in South Sudan in 1998, hindered the further exploitation of solar energy as a means of producing energy on a wider scale as Sudan became heavily reliant on its oil resources in the South. In 2011, a referendum paved the way for South Sudan to declare its independence as a separate state.
