



Is goodwill tax deductible in Zimbabwe? A recovery or recoupment of allowances previously claimed should be included in the gross income of a taxpayer in the event that the allowance is recovered or recouped by way of disposal. The recoupment is calculated on the capital allowances previously granted. Goodwill is currently not deductible for tax purposes in Zimbabwe.



What is Zimbabwe's energy infrastructure? Without a doubt, Zimbabwe's energy infrastructure is in dire need of massive improvements in order to stabilize and centralize the nation's domestic energy output. The renewable energy potential of Zimbabwe is revolves around 3 main aspects: hydropower, solar power, and biogas.



Why is there a disparity between electricity supply & demand in Zimbabwe? Zimbabwe's electrical grid is sorely in need of maintenance and upgrades, which has led to a disparity between the supply and demand of electrical energy. While the total demand for electricity is 2029 MW, the supply is only around 1200 MW. This disparity is also created by the outdated status of the electrical power stations.

(Source: Wikimedia Commons) Zimbabwe is a landlocked country with an energy profile mainly divided amongst wood fuel (61%),petroleum (18%),electricity (13%),and coal (8%).



How is electricity produced in Zimbabwe? Zimbabwe's electrical power is generated by two methods: coal and hydropower. None of the coal powered plants (Hwange,Bulawayo,Harare,Munyati) meet their advertised power output. The Hwange plant boasts an installed capacity of 920 MW (megawatts),yet it only produces about 400-500 MW.





Does Zimbabwe have a coal plant? Even worse, the rest of the coal plants rarely generate electricity. Coal production is further complicated by the fact that Zimbabwe only has 502 tonsof coal reserves left as of the end of 2017. This amount does not suffice to keep providing the energy necessary for its plants and burgeoning population.





In 2021, energy supply in Zimbabwe is a mix of hydropower (70%), coal (29%) and renewable energy sources, according to the Zimbabwe Energy Regulatory Authority. Over the past five years, independent power producers (IPPs) have explored alternative energy sources such as solar, wind, geothermal, biofuels and biomass.
